We need to have an ear to hear what the Lord is speaking to us. We need to be the best receivers for the Lord to infuse us with His word. We are at the end of this age. May we all, especially the young brothers and sisters among us, excel in the book of Revelation. We should look at this book not only from the standpoint of the prophecies. We should **be able to understand the entire book and develop some measure of constitution**. Of course, this takes time, but we really must excel in the book of Revelation because we are in the days of Revelation.

Both the believers and the people in the world need to hear the truth. We need to proclaim the truth, to herald the truth, but we do not do this as a kind of outward performance. We need young people who are constituted with the truth, so that when they are on the campus or in the workplace, they will speak out of their constitution concerning the things that they have enjoyed. For this **there is no other way but to labor on the Word**. We must **redeem the time and take advantage of the opportunities**. Thankfully, in the Lord's recovery we have the ministry of the age; we have the opportunity to dig into the truth, to gain the truth, and to be constituted with the truth.

The Word is a gold mine. May we all aspire to enter into this mine. When we enter into it, we may not see that much initially. We may not be that impressed. We need to do some digging to get the gold, to lay hold of the precious minerals. The days are evil, filled with so many other things. **Satan's strategy is to cause the young people to waste their time**. This is why Paul says that we need to redeem the time (Eph. 5:16). **We need to buy it back and save our time for the things that really matter. Young people, if you use your time to be constituted with the truth, it will benefit you and others**. This is very much needed among us.

This message is based on Revelation 3:7-22. These verses concern the churches in Philadelphia and Laodicea. We should understand the context of these verses. In Revelation 2 and 3 we see that concerning the churches, the Lord approves of certain things and disapproves of other things. The seven epistles to the seven churches in these chapters are a record of the actual situation that existed in those churches at that time. Of course, there were many more churches than the seven identified in these chapters, but the Lord selected these seven churches in His sovereignty.

Because the book of Revelation is a book of signs (1:1), these seven churches are also signs of the historical chronology, or development, of the church in this age. Thus, we see the progression of the church in seven stages. At the beginning of each epistle the Lord is speaking. He identifies Himself in a particular way according to the need that He perceives in that church. He sees the real condition and situation of each church and therefore identifies Himself in a particular way at the beginning of each epistle in order to meet the need in each church. This is quite striking.

Whenever we listen to the speaking of the seven Spirits of God to the churches, we are immediately under a precious, sweet, and dear transfusing, an infusing that changes us, transforms us, makes us the proper material, and builds us into God's building. **We need to keep ourselves under the speaking of the seven Spirits**. We should not be carried off by our religious concepts. **We should not let the subtle enemy trick us into thinking that we need to improve ourselves, that we need to be better brothers or sisters**. This will distract us from the Spirit's speaking, and we will miss out on the infusion of Christ. It is the infusion of Christ that changes us, that transforms us.

We need to pay attention to the written Word, the spoken word, and the fellowship. We must exercise our spirit to touch the sevenfold intensified Spirit. Then the Lord will have the ground to infuse His life into us. **This is not a matter of behavioral modification**. It is in this way that we become the proper material for God's building. The proper material is not natural; it is both divine and human. We need the divine element imparted into us. This takes place through the speaking of the seven Spirits of God to the churches...As the Spirit is speaking to the churches, we all need an opened, circumcised, cleansed, and anointed ear to hear the Spirit's speaking. **The Spirit is always speaking; the Spirit does His part**. The Spirit is speaking to the churches. **The question is, how much are we hearing? How much are we receiving?** For this we need an opened, circumcised, cleansed, and anointed ear.

This is a serious matter. **Our hearing governs our ability to receive the things of the Spirit and to gain the benefit of the Spirit's speaking**. We may be in a meeting, but we feel like we are not receiving that much. Our tendency may be to criticize the meeting. However, **the problem** more often has to do with the **condition of our ears**. We may be occupied with other things. We may have something else on our mind. Maybe we have been offended. Maybe we do not want to listen to the brother who is speaking, or we do not want to listen to the saints as they prophesy. For whatever reason, **we are distracted**. However, is the problem with the meeting, or is the problem with our receiving? We need to deal with this matter of our hearing so that our ears will be circumcised. Otherwise, we will miss the benefit of the Spirit's speaking to the churches (Excerpts from The Ministry of the Word, vol. 30, no. 02, pp. 170-192).
